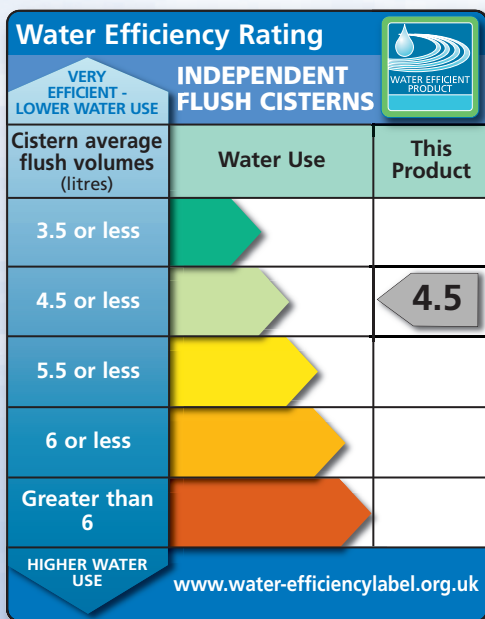

WC Suites & Independent Flushing Cisterns

There are two types of cisterns that can offer significant water saving, single flush and dual flush. Regulation dictates that all new WCs must use no more than 6 litres of water per flush. Dual flush WCs will have two buttons - one for the full flush and one for part flush. The part flush button will be used most of the time, saving as much as 33% of water per flush.

If your existing WC is more than 10 years old, you may be using more than 7.5 litres of water per flush, replacing with an ultra modern efficient WC could save you more than 45% of water per flush.

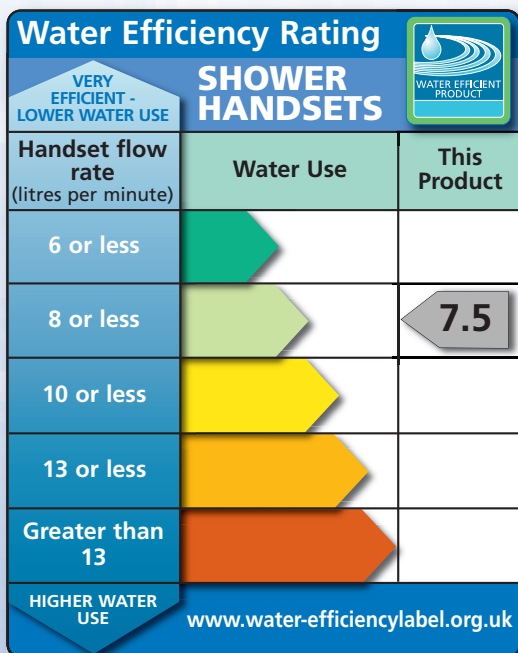
